## Safeguarding Children

Please inform the school before 9.15 a.m by leaving a message on the absent line, if your child is going to be absent.

The Attendance Officer will then check to see if there are any unexplained absences and if there are will contact parents.

This procedure is set in place to safeguard all children. Please inform us on the first day and keep us updated if your child is going to be absent for more than a day.

If your child is off school more than three days medical evidence will be required. This can be in the way of a prescription or the medication prescribed, a doctor's stamp in your child's diary, an appointment card with the time and date attended or a medical certificate.
